Faculty of Nursing

Helwan University

The establishment of the Faculty of Nursing at Helwan University was approved by the University Council on November 26, 2006, following the approval of the Nursing Sector Committee on September 6, 2006.

A presidential decree (No. 267 of 2006) was issued to amend certain provisions of the executive regulations of the Universities Organization Law, including the establishment of the Faculty of Nursing at Helwan University. The faculty officially began its academic activities in the 2007/2008 academic year as a general nursing program.

It is considered the first academic healthcare institution within Helwan University and the Governorate of Helwan, offering healthcare and nursing services both within and outside the university.

The language of instruction at the Faculty is English, and the curriculum includes Nursing Sciences, Medical Sciences, and Behavioral Sciences.

The Faculty comprises six academic departments:

- Adult Health Nursing
- Pediatric Health Nursing
- Maternal and Newborn Health Nursing
- Community Health Nursing
- Psychiatric and Mental Health Nursing
- Nursing Administration

The duration of study to obtain a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.Sc. Nursing) is four academic years, followed by a mandatory one-year internship (12 months) in hospitals and healthcare institutions under the supervision of the Faculty.

A Postgraduate Studies Department has been established at the Faculty since 2013, offering Master's and Doctoral degrees in Nursing.

The Faculty also offers an **Intensive Nursing Program** designed for students who already hold a Bachelor's or Licentiate degree with a cumulative GPA of no less than 60%, provided they hold a secondary school certificate in the science track. Upon successful completion of the 24-month program, followed by a 6-month internship, students are awarded a **second bachelor's degree in Nursing Science**. The program consists of six consecutive academic semesters, in addition to a preparatory term.

- 2. Assigning a designated staff member in each faculty to communicate with international students and address their concerns.
- 3. Completing all required security clearances for international students.
- 4. Coordinating with various embassies and the International Students
 Department at the Ministry of Higher Education to resolve any student-related issues.
- 5. Facilitating housing for international students in university-owned accommodations, such as the University Guest House on campus or the Hotel of the Faculty of Tourism and Hotels in Manial, both for a reasonable monthly fee
- 6. Organizing regular meetings between international students and the university's International Students Office staff to discuss challenges and propose solutions. Communication channels include telephone, email, and a dedicated Facebook page.
- 7. Arranging trips to explore Egypt's tourist attractions under the supervision of faculty from the Tourism Guidance Department Faculty of Tourism and Hotels.
- 8. Organizing the **Annual International Day** every May.
- 9. Holding an annual meeting between university leadership and cultural attachés from various embassies.
- 10. Conducting marketing campaigns in Gulf countries in collaboration with Egyptian cultural attachés to attract more Arab students.
- 11. Providing comprehensive information about all academic programs, especially those unique to Helwan University.
- 12. Showcasing the academic achievements of faculty members, including recipients of national and international scientific awards.







Undergraduate Stage

Admission Requirements for the Faculty of Nursing:

- Obtaining the Egyptian General Secondary Education Certificate (Thanaweya Amma) or its equivalent.
- Passing the required qualifying subjects and meeting the minimum total grade required for admission to the Faculty.

Where to Submit Documents:

Applicants must submit their academic documents either to their embassy in Cairo or to:

Required Documents for Applying to the Faculty of Nursing:


- 1. An accredited and authenticated equivalent high school certificate, attested by the Embassy of the Arab Republic of Egypt in the country where the certificate was obtained, or by the embassy of that country in Cairo.
 - Students who obtained the Egyptian General Secondary Education Certificate must submit the original success form (white form).
- 2. Original birth certificate or an official extract.
- 3. Original passport.
- 4. Letter from the embassy for applicants applying through their embassy.
- 5. Twelve (12) recent passport-sized photos.
- 6. Certificate of passing the Faculty of Nursing's aptitude test.
- Receipt of a postal order or cheque made out to the Fund for the Welfare of International Students and Their Clubs
 (Account No. 5 / 82144 / 450 / 9) at the Central Bank of Egypt in the amount of 150 EGP as application fees.

How to Authenticate Certificates:

Authentication refers to the official validation of certificates. This process involves:


- 1. Initial authentication by the institution that issued the certificate.
- 2. Authentication by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the issuing country.
- 3. Authentication by the Egyptian Embassy in that country.

Alternatively, certificates may be authenticated by the embassy of the country that issued the certificate in **Cairo**, followed by authentication at the **Egyptian Ministry of Foreign Affairs** (with the exception of certificates issued in the Americas, Russia, and Eastern Europe).

Certificates that are not authenticated through the proper channels, or those authenticated only by Egyptian embassies abroad or by the Egyptian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, will not be considered.

Certificates Not Yet Equated:

If the student holds a certificate that has not yet been equated to the Egyptian General Secondary Education Certificate, the following steps should be taken:

- Submit the certificate to the Egyptian Embassy in the country of residence and request equivalency with the Egyptian General Secondary Certificate, OR
- Submit the certificate to the **Equivalency Department at the Ministry of Education in Egypt**, along with the following:
- 1. A detailed report on the educational system in the certificate-issuing country, including:
 - Educational stages
 - Duration of each stage
 - Types of educational tracks
- 2. A detailed report on the secondary stage, covering:
 - o Curricula and study plans
 - o Distribution of subjects across academic years
 - Weekly hours per subject
- 3. A statement listing the universities in the home country and abroad that accept this certificate.







All attachments must be officially certified by the issuing authority.

Decision of the Supreme Council of Universities

Session dated January 27, 2000 Concerning the Admission Regulations for International Students at Egyptian Universities

1. Exemption from Foreign Language Requirement:

International students who obtained an equivalent high school certificate are exempted from the requirement to pass a foreign language subject which they did not study under the education system of the country from which they received their certificate.

However, if that language is part of the academic program of the faculty or department to which the student is applying, the student must sit for an exam in that subject. In this case, the student shall not be awarded a bachelor's or licentiate degree unless they successfully pass the exam.

2. Continued Exemption from Arabic Language and National Subjects: International students who obtained a foreign equivalent high school certificate and were admitted to Egyptian universities shall continue to be exempted from the supplementary examinations in Arabic Language, Religious Education, and National Education, provided that Arabic is not their native language and they did not study it during their secondary education.

3. Admission Criteria Equivalence:

The admission of international students to universities shall follow the same criteria applied to students holding the Egyptian General Secondary Certificate (Thanaweya Amma), in accordance with the qualifying subjects required by each faculty.

If an international student's certificate lacks any of the required qualifying subjects, the student shall be admitted to a faculty that does not consider the missing subject as one of its admission prerequisites.

Postgraduate Studies

Faculty of Nursing – Helwan University

Required Documents:

- 1. Original or certified copy of the General Secondary Education Certificate (authenticated), along with three (3) photocopies.
- 2. Original or certified copy of the Bachelor's/Licentiate degree certificate (authenticated), along with three (3) photocopies.
- 3. Equivalency certificate from the Supreme Council of Universities confirming that the student's academic transcript aligns with the requirements of the Faculty of Nursing.
- 4. Original or certified copy of the academic transcript (course list) (authenticated), along with three (3) photocopies.
- 5. **A guide from the degree-granting institution** (institute/college/university/academy, etc.) detailing:
 - Admission requirements
 - o Graduation requirements
 - Course content
 Plus three (3) photocopies (only of the sections containing the required information).
- 6. **An official letter from the degree-granting institution** confirming full-time attendance throughout the duration of study.
- 7. **Passport**, including all visa pages indicating residency in the country where the degree was obtained, plus **one** (1) **photocopy**.
- 8. **An official letter from the student's embassy** addressed to the Dean of the Faculty, stating preliminary approval for study.

Authentication and Certification:

- All certificates and documents must be authenticated by the **Egyptian Cultural Office** in the country where the issuing institution is located, or by
 the **embassy of that country** in Egypt, **in addition to authentication by the Egyptian Ministry of Foreign Affairs**.
- Documents must be submitted in **Arabic or English**. If issued in another language, a **certified translation** must be attached.

Accommodation

Helwan University provides a distinguished **Guest House**, which serves various purposes including academic, cultural, and social activities for the university community.

The Guest House offers hotel-standard services, including accommodation and meals, for visiting professors—both Egyptian and international—as well as for international postgraduate students.

It also serves as a venue for hosting conferences, scientific seminars, and various types of events and celebrations.



Guest House Rooms

The Guest House is a four-story building, with the guest rooms located on the third floor. This floor consists of 12 rooms, including single, double, triple rooms, and suites. Each room on this floor has a private bathroom. Room rates vary depending on whether breakfast is included or not.

The second floor contains 8 rooms designated for female guests and includes 2 shared bathrooms serving these rooms.

The first floor has 8 rooms for male guests, along with 2 shared bathrooms for their use.

The ground floor includes a conference hall, an exhibition hall, and lounges for receiving guests during various university events.







Health Insurance

Helwan University provides healthcare services for international students. Informational signboards are placed at the university entrance, guiding students about the available medical units within the faculties and the Medical Administration.

There are 24-hour clinics for students located in Building 9 (for male students) and Building 12 (for female students) within the university dormitories on campus.

Every student has the right to visit the medical unit affiliated with their faculty, whether inside or outside the campus, to request a health card. This card serves as their medical file, which is kept active throughout their years of study. To receive the medical file, students must present their current academic year college ID card.

In case of a sudden illness or accident on campus, students should immediately go to the faculty clinics or the Medical Administration. If an emergency occurs off campus, students should go to Helwan University Hospital in Helwan, the nearest public hospital, or any of the hospitals contracted with the university, which include:

- Students' Hospital in Giza
- Agouza Hospital
- Heliopolis Hospital
- Bahman Psychiatric Hospital in Helwan
- Dar Al-Mogattam Psychiatric Hospital
- French Kasr Al-Ainy Hospital

Students are admitted under the standard second-class category. The university must be notified through the Medical Administration at phone number **25569518** within 48 hours of admission, along with a medical report detailing the condition.

Sports and Cultural Activities

International students at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels are entitled to participate in all activities offered by the General Administration for Youth Welfare, except for running in student union elections. These activities include:

- **Family Student Activities:** Programs designed to support student families and promote community bonding.
- **Sports Activities:** Focused on developing students' athletic talents, forming sports teams, and organizing matches and competitions.
- **Cultural Activities:** Aimed at nurturing creative, cultural, and media-related talents among students.
- Artistic Activities: Dedicated to showcasing students' artistic abilities and refining their creative skills.







- Scouting and Community Service: Implementing community service programs, supporting scouting movements, and participating in public service projects.
- Social Activities and Trips: Encouraging cooperation among students, faculty members, and staff, as well as organizing social, cultural, and recreational trips and camps.
- Scientific and Technological Activities: Organizing seminars and scientific lectures to develop scientific and technological skills and disseminate knowledge through science clubs and academic societies.
